Effective Immediately

Updates to our current Visitation Policy, applies to indoor and outdoor visits:

- If the resident is in a single-person room, visitation will continue to occur in their room.
- When visitation is occurring in a designated area in the facility, everyone in the designated area should wear source control and physical distancing should be maintained between different visitation groups *regardless* of vaccination status.
- Visitors are required to wear a well fitted mask and physically distance from other healthcare personnel and other residents/visitors that are not part of their group at all other times.
- Physical distancing and source control recommendations when both the resident and all of their visitors are **fully vaccinated**:
 - o While alone in the resident's room or the designated visitation room, residents and their visitor(s) can choose to have close contact (including touch) and to not wear source control well fitted mask.
- Physical distancing and source control recommendations when *either* the resident OR any of their visitor(s) are **not fully vaccinated**:
 - o All individuals (visitor(s) and resident) must maintain physical distancing and are required to wear source control well fitted mask. However, if the resident is fully vaccinated, they can choose to have close contact (including touch) with their unvaccinated visitor(s) while both continue to wear well-fitting source control mask.

Lastly, we have lifted some restraints on pet visits. Pets are allowed to visit outdoors. The owner of the pet is responsible for ensuring the pet remains on a leash at all times and does not come in contact with other residents, visitors or healthcare personnel.

"Fully vaccinated" refers to a person who is ≥ 2 weeks following receipt of the second dose in a 2-dose series, or ≥ 2 weeks following receipt of one dose of a single-dose vaccine.

"Unvaccinated" refers to a person who does not fit the definition of "fully vaccinated," including people whose vaccination status is not known, for the purposes of this guidance.
