Visitation guidance from CMS released November 12th, 2021:

Prior to the most recent update from CMS, visitation was limited; however, we are overjoyed to announce visitation is now open for indoor (expanded beyond compassionate care) and outdoor visitation!! In summary, all visitors will continue to be required to be screened prior to entering the building, maintain social distancing from other residents and staff, wear a well-fitted mask during the entire visit regardless of vaccination status. The most pronounced updates to the visitation guidance include but are not limited to: no time limit on the visitation, no limit on the amount of visitors at any given time (must have the ability to maintain at least 6 feet from others (i.e.: other residents and staff)) and visitors are no longer required to call in advance for an appointment; however, we appreciate your cooperation on the screening process and the space available for those who reside in a share room. Please share this notice with others; we are so thankful for this change and cannot wait to have you back more frequently!!

Our face mask and physically distance (6+ feet apart) are determined on the county transmission rate. The guide below provides an outline of the expectation regardless of the visitor's vaccination status.

Moderate to Low	Well-fitted Face Mask and Physically Distance is <i>Recommended</i>
Substantial to High	Well-fitted Face Mask and Physically Distance is REQUIRED

We continue to offer chat box visits, Facetime, Google Duo, Zoom or Skype.

Continuing Core Principles of COVID-19 Infection Prevention at our Center include at minimum:

- Screening of all who enter the facility for signs and symptoms of COVID-19
- Hand hygiene (use of alcohol-based hand rub is preferred).
- Face covering or mask (covering mouth and nose).
- Social distancing at least six feet between persons.
- Instructional signage throughout the facility and proper visitor education on COVID19 signs and symptoms, infection control precautions, other applicable facility practices (e.g., use of face covering or mask, specified entries, exits and routes to designated areas, hand hygiene).
- Cleaning & disinfecting high touched surfaces in the facility often & designated visitation areas after each visit.
- Appropriate staff use of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).
- Effective cohorting of residents (e.g., separate areas dedicated COVID-19 care).
- Resident and staff testing conducted as required.
