



Updated to the reported information on 10/10/2020:

The staff member completed two PCR tests. The results of the tests were both negative which supports the fact the rapid was a false positive. This individual was released by Public Health to return to work.

10/10/2020:

On October 10th, a single staff member tested positive for COVID-19 with a PCR test. This individual has not been working since September 21st, 2020 and has been in quarantine due to a known exposure. During the quarantine period, the individual developed symptoms of COVID-19 and obtained a PCR test offsite on October 9th. Please note, this individual has not been in the building since September 21st, 2020. We have been advised by Butler County Public Health to not test residents due to the amount of time this individual has not been on our campus. This individual will remain in isolation and remain off of work until released from the Local Public Health Department.

Continuing Core Principles of COVID-19 Infection Prevention at our Center include:

- Screening of all who enter the facility for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 (e.g., temperature checks, questions or observations about signs or symptoms), and denial of entry of those with signs or symptoms.
- Hand hygiene (use of alcohol-based hand rub is preferred).
- Face covering or mask (covering mouth and nose).
- Social distancing at least six feet between persons.
- Instructional signage throughout the facility and proper visitor education on COVID19 signs and symptoms, infection control precautions, other applicable facility practices (e.g., use of face covering or mask, specified entries, exits and routes to designated areas, hand hygiene).
- Cleaning and disinfecting high frequency touched surfaces in the facility often, and designated visitation areas after each visit.
- Appropriate staff use of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).
- Effective cohorting of residents (e.g., separate areas dedicated COVID-19 care).
- Resident and staff testing conducted as required.
