On November 6th, a single staff member tested positive for COVID-19 with a rapid antigen test. This individual was symptomatic and obtained a rapid antigen test offsite on November 6th, 2020 at another location. We have been advised by Butler County Public Health to complete testing of all residents for COVID-19. The resident specimens were obtained today, November 6th, 2020. This individual will remain in isolation and remain off of work until released from the Local Public Health Department.

Continuing Core Principles of COVID-19 Infection Prevention at our Center include:

- Screening of all who enter the facility for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 (e.g., temperature checks, questions or observations about signs or symptoms), and denial of entry of those with signs or symptoms.
- Hand hygiene (use of alcohol-based hand rub is preferred).
- Face covering or mask (covering mouth and nose).
- Social distancing at least six feet between persons.
- Instructional signage throughout the facility and proper visitor education on COVID19 signs and symptoms, infection control precautions, other applicable facility practices (e.g., use of face covering or mask, specified entries, exits and routes to designated areas, hand hygiene).
- Cleaning and disinfecting high frequency touched surfaces in the facility often, and designated visitation areas after each visit.
- Appropriate staff use of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).
- Effective cohorting of residents (e.g., separate areas dedicated COVID-19 care).
- Resident and staff testing conducted as required.
